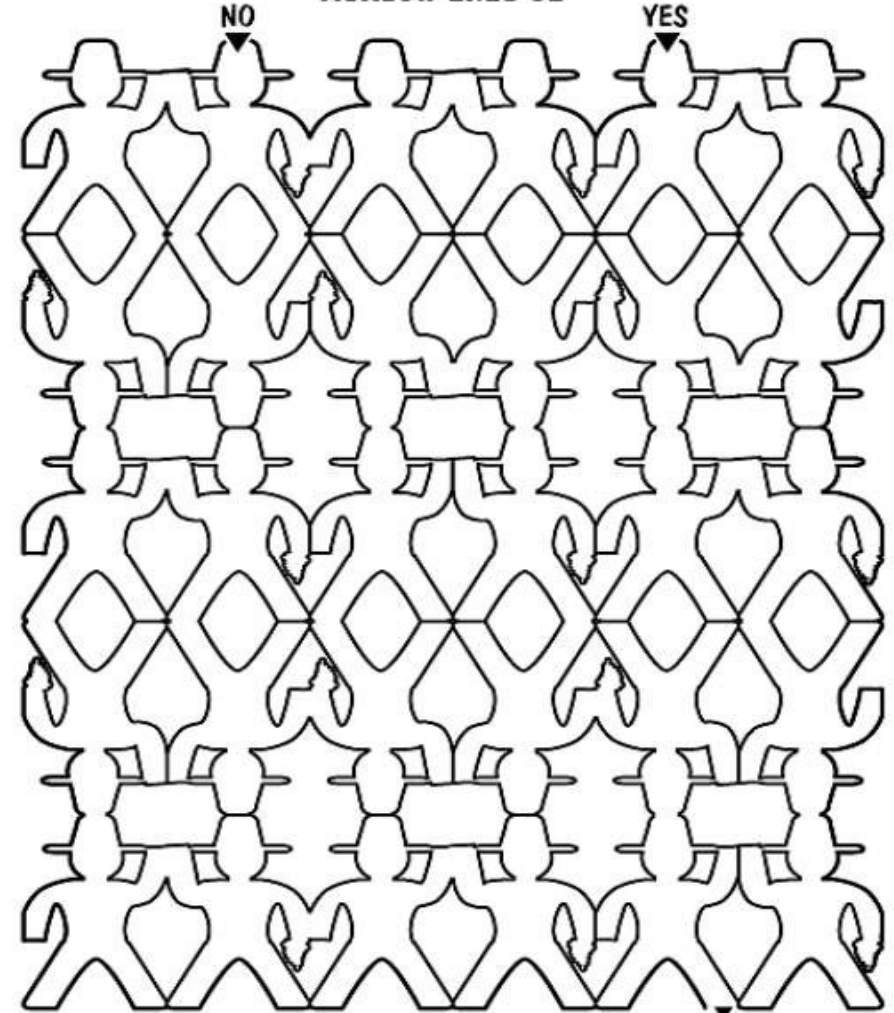


Find your way through the Maze

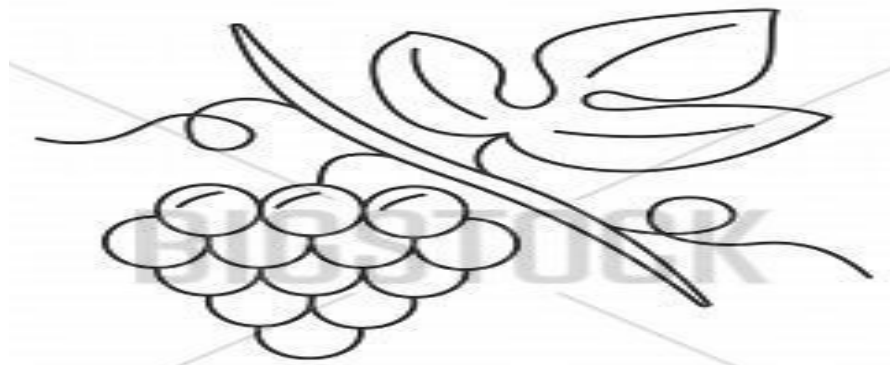

How to Dial-a-Message:

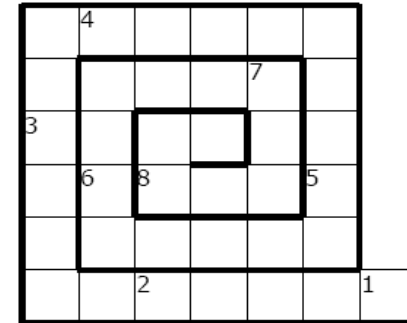
The first number tells you what circle to look at on the dial. The second number tells you which letter to write down (for example, 6-1 is "M").
