Message for the Second Sunday in Ordinary Time.

John is unusually precise about the amount of wine Jesus produced at the wedding feast at Cana.

"There were six stone water jars...each could hold twenty or thirty gallons."

By my reckoning, that means that Jesus produced around twelve hundred pints of wine, or over one thousand bottles!

Cana, in Jesus' time, is likely to have been a small village, of perhaps no more than two hundred and fifty inhabitants. Even if they all came to the marriage feast, as is likely, they would have had four bottles of wine each. That's quite a party!

The point, surely, is about God's generosity. He is prepared to reward His people with a superabundance of good things.

When Mary asks Jesus to help out the steward, he gives her a rather stuffy reply, "Woman, why turn to me?" But Mary knows he can do it and tells the steward, "Do whatever he tells you." The message is that if we have faith in Jesus, there is no limit to what God will give us.

Closing date for applications is 26 January 2022.


