## **Message for the Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time.**

Peter and his brother Andrew and the brothers James and John, were fishermen. But Jesus had other ideas, he wanted them to be Apostles, people who would devote their lives to spreading the good news about him and his mission. How was he going to persuade them to leave their fishing businesses and follow him?

Perhaps the obvious way would have been for Jesus to cause the supply of fish in the Sea of Galilee to dry up. If their businesses failed, then they might have seen that they had no alternative than to become his disciples.

In fact, he does the opposite; he gives them the greatest catch they have ever had. There's a message here about vocation. Following Jesus shouldn't be a last resort when everything else has failed. Discipleship is the fulfilment of a happy and successful life - not an alternative!
