Typically, we have 16 children and 8 adults plus an number of volunteers. Food has included baked potatoes with a variety of fillings, fried chicken with sweet and sour sauce, meat free bolognese sauce with pasta and sausages and mash. There is always a green salad plus fresh bread and there is always fresh fruit salad plus jelly and ice cream for desert. The children have thoroughly enjoyed the activities which are both fun and educational. We will be continuing for at least another two weeks, and I am grateful to all the volunteers but particularly those volunteers from Sacred Heart. I would also like to thank the parishioner who gave me a donation for Grub Club last week. If anyone knows of any families who would benefit from this provision, please encourage them to come along.
