In today's Gospel parable, Jesus contrasts the self-satisfied prayer of the Pharisee with the humble prayer of the tax collector.

There's little doubt that the Pharisee was the better person of the two and yet, remarkably, Jesus tells us that it was the tax collector went home at rights with God.

Jesus was remarkably tolerant of sinners. He even sought out their company and attracted criticism for doing so. The one thing he couldn't abide was hypocrisy: the sin of self-delusion.

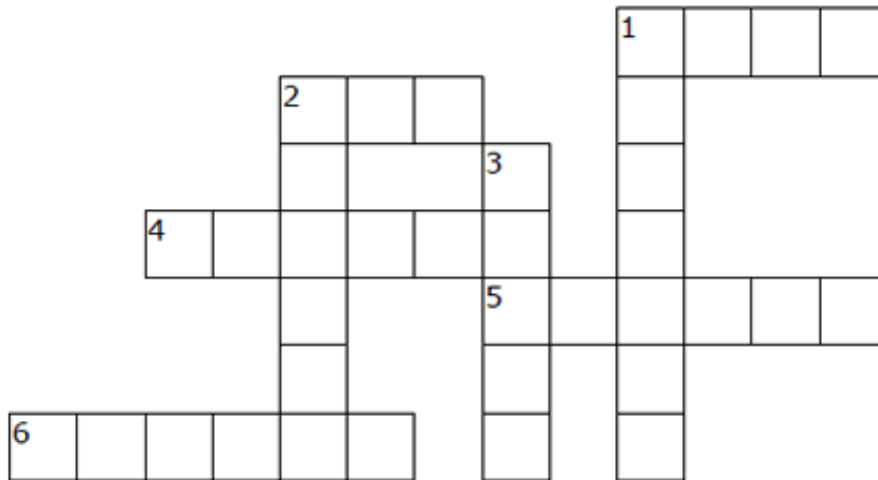
